Those with Economics or Maths degrees may enjoy our Analytical Fast Stream, and anyone with a desire to work in diplomacy or international relations should consider trying out for the Diplomatic Service, which starts with 2 years working for the Foreign and Commonwealth Office before working abroad in one of our Embassies or High Commissions.

The Central Departments option of the Graduate Fast Stream could place you in any government department: you could be working on environmental and climate change issues, the economy, social policy, counter terrorism, higher education funding or even the Olympics.
